

Hales Corners Library Unattended Children Policy

For a child under the age of 9, the parent, guardian or an assigned caregiver must remain in the library while the child is in a library program.

For a child age 9 or older, the parent, guardian or an assigned caregiver may leave the library for the duration of the program but are expected to return before the program is over and be available to meet their child when he/she comes out of the program.

If a child (regardless of age) requires continuous supervision, the parent, guardian or assigned caregiver shall remain in the program with the child.
